

Shaare Zedek honors Paskow

Sunny Isles Beach resident Stuart Paskow recently received the Healers of Jerusalem Award by The American Committee for Shaare Zedek Medical Center in Jerusalem at its national dinner in New York City.

Paskow, a co-founder of Mitch Stuart Inc. who runs its East Coast office in North Miami Beach, was honored along with his colleague and fellow MSI co-founder Michelle Cohen, who heads the company's West Coast office in California. Paskow has been involved with the organization since 2003 and, along with Cohen, has served as an architect, designer and creative visionary behind Shaare Zedek's direct mail program, which has raised millions of dollars for the hospital. The American Committee for Shaare Zedek Medical Center in Jerusalem raises funds to support the hospital's work.

"They [organization] do so many things that it's an incredible honor and a privilege for me to work with them and to be honored by them was one of the most exciting and honorable things that has ever happened to me," Paskow said. "I am just so absolutely amazed by it."

Paskow mentioned that there are so many things that the hospital does to treat not only the people of Israel, but everyone throughout the world.

"I had the privilege of visiting the hospital and seeing Jewish, Christian and Arab doctors working together with only one purpose — to save lives," Paskow said.
